Please Note:

A. If you wish to be considered for the Oklahoma Ready Mixed Concrete Association scholarship, include also a project or activity demonstrating creative and practical use of concrete products in design and construction. Examples: publication, class paper or design project, community project, construction project, exhibit, lecture.

B. If you are applying for the Lippert Bros., Inc. Scholarship, you must be accepted into the Construction Science junior year, you must have worked in the commercial or municipal construction industry for a minimum of 1 summer (or equivalent period of time), your career goals must be focused on commercial or municipal construction, and you must have been active in University, College or Division activities.
