

## **Jeffrey W. Burquest Memorial Scholarship**

The University of Oklahoma College of Architecture is honored to announce the establishment of the Jeffrey W. Burquest Memorial Scholarship. Endowed by Dr. and Mrs. Donald A. Burquest and Jane Burquest Childers, the scholarship is in memory of their son and brother Jeffrey.

Jeffrey Weston Burquest was born in a mission hospital in Vom, Nigeria, on February 25, 1970. In 1975 his family moved to Cedar Hill, Texas, where he attended Bray Elementary School and Cedar Hill High School. Early on he showed a gift for drawing and while in high school won regional and state awards in drafting competitions. Mr. Burquest came to the University of Oklahoma in 1988, and graduated in 1991 with a Bachelor of Architecture. After graduation he was employed with Richards-Oyer Architects (now ARCHISTUDIO, Inc.) until his death in September 1994. His untimely death prevented him from expressing his Christian faith through architecture to the extent that he wanted.

The scholarship has been established for upper division students pursuing the Bachelor of Architecture degree at the University of Oklahoma who are in good academic standing and show promise of creativity.
